You'll find an amalgam of flavour in Flaming Heart: You'll detect the peatiness of our favourite Islay malt whisky distillery...

- ...And you'll pick up malty and fruity notes of one or two of our favourite Highland malt distilleries...
- ...And you'll definitely pick up aromas that remind you of clove and cardamom and cinnamon alongside dried fruit character and stone fruit character...
- ...You'll experience a big, full palate of flavour, it will be rich on the palate, a touch sweet on the palate, but balanced...
- ...You'll experience an extremely long and complex finish with echoes of peat and smoke alongside spices and fruit.

And best of all, after your first taste, you will be called immediately back to the glass for another, and another. It's that type of whisky. Which is so amazing, given the bigness, the fullness, the complexity. And given it's bottled at 48.9%! We're pretty sure you've never tasted a malt whisky like this before

Flavour Descriptors:	Peat and smoke, wrapped up in rich, spice and dried fruit-laden maltiness.
Recommendations:	When you're ready for a full-on mouthful of malt.
Distillery Sourcing:	Single malts from the villages of Port Askaig (Islay) for the smoke & peat, and Brora and Longmorn for the richness and spice-fruit complexity. Aged up to 16 years.
Wood:	Islay whisky from refill American oak hogsheads, other malts from new French oak.
Bottling Details:	Bottled at 48.9% Abv. Natural Colour. Not Chill Filtered. Bottled just over 350 six-pack cases in 70cl bottles.
